Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS)

This is 4&1/2 year course. Admissions are made through U.P.State Combined Pre Medical Test (CPMT) conducted by Director Medical Education & Training , UP for 85% of seats and the All India Medical Entranance Examination (CBSE Examination) Conducted by All India Institute Of Medical Sciences, New Delhi for the remaining 15% Seats. Reservation of seats for scheduled castes/tribes and other backward classes are nade according to state government rules.

The course Structure and content is set according to the guideline Laid down by the Medical Council Of India. It consists of 9 semesters, each of 6 months duration. The First 2 Semesters (First Professional) are devoted to the pre-clinical subject-Anatomy, Physiology and biochemistry and after this period of 12 months the 1st professional examination is held. In next 3 semesters (second professional), the student studies is examined in Pathology, Microbiology, Pharmacology and Forensic medicine. During Last 4 Semesters (Third Professional) , The student studies the clinical subjects- Medicine, Including tuberculosis and chest diseases, Phychiatry, Dermatology, surgery, Pediatrics, Obstetrics and Gynecology ,Orthopedics, Ophthalmology, otorhinolaryngology and community medicine through lectures , Demonstration and clinical postings. The Final professional examination and the clinical subjects include written, clinical and oral part. According to the Medical Council Of India, a candidate must have at least 75% attendance in clinical postings and lectures and also have at least

35% marks in the internal assessment to be eligible to be appear in the professional examination.

Candidates are eligible for entrance to this course after completing internship. The number of seats in each course is decided from time to time. Admissions are made through UP State Post Graduate Medical Entrance Examination (UP PGMEET) for 50% of the seats

and the All India Post Graduate Medical Entrance Examinations, conducted by DGHS , New Delhi For 50 % seats. Reservation of seats for scheduled castes/tribes and other backward classes is made according to UP Government rules.

Recognition of these courses by Medical Council Of India should be ascertained at the time of admission.

The State Government conducts entrance examination for admission to various Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Super specialty courses by authorizing any University or Medical College. A Counseling Board constituted by the State Government for this purpose conducts the counseling for allotment of seats. The Director General of Medical Education is the Chairperson of the Counselling Board. The candidates selected by the Counseling Procedure are issued allotment letters duly signed by the competent authority and on production of the allotment letter; the allotted candidates are

admitted in the college. They are also required to produce all the original certificates and admit card at the time of admission along with admission fee.
